

Our initiative tackles the barriers hindering marginalized communities. Rooted in four foundational pillars: college readiness, mentorship, wellness, and standardized testing – our program offers a comprehensive approach to holistic development.

As our studets are getting prepared for college, we are currently offering SAT prep courses! Our incredibly talented tutors and organizers began their 9week long work with two D.C. Public High Schools, Dunbar High School and Cardozo Education Campus.
